Minutes of the June 13th, 2019 groundwater meeting were presented by Josh Stolzenburg. **M/S, Lisa Anderson/O'Carroll**, move to approve the minutes, all in favor, motion carried.

Lisa Anderson was chosen as chair of the committee. **M/S, Stolzenburg/Tor Anderson**, move to approve Lisa Anderson as chair, all in favor, motion carried.

Addition to committee: Bob Conachen has agreed to serve on the committee. Looking for one more.

Retesting is set for the week of July 8th. Bob will hand out bottles, collect samples, and take them to the lab. We have about 25 homes signed up.

The public needs to be informed about the need to test post reverse osmosis systems to ensure the systems are still capable of removing nitrates to a safe level.

Tarion asked to have a resolution considered by the committee that is similar to one adopted by Port Edwards. He will prepare it for the next meeting with Village of Nelsonville language.

Tarion asked for the committee to consider at the next meeting certain farmer-based solutions that he brought.

Tor is going to work on preparations for the WQTF (Water Quality Task Force) hearings in Stevens Point on July 24th. We don't have a time or location yet.

Tor received historical test results from the county. Lisa has worked on entering those into the results spreadsheet.

Lisa and Tor shared information about the unscheduled visit their family had with Tammy Baldwin's office in Washington D.C. Her policy advisor is willing to speak to our committee by conference call if we'd like.

There is going to be a presentation at the mill on July 25th: State of the Tomorrow River. Josh will add an agenda item to the board meeting to discuss and decide if the village would like to be a cosponsor of the event.
