APPROVED MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by President Bobby Bailey

The purpose of the meeting was to have community discussion about the water drainage problems on 1st Street and potential solutions.

There was much discussion about options ranging from more of a quick fix to a major overhaul that would address functional plus aesthetic concerns.

The consensus was to split the projects into two phases. Jerry Trzebiatowski and Wally Leppen will meet Judah Haas on March 7th at 5:00 to discuss options for addressing the immediate water drainage problems. Some thoughts discussed at the meeting concerning this project involve narrowing SS/1st Street, raise curbs, move sidewalks, route drainage, and/or use catch basins. There was agreement that this repair should happen within the next few months.

Future Development: Have a more aesthetically pleasing, functional vision for the city. Tom from Alchemy might be able to draw up diagrams. Email addresses were gathered for those interested in participating on a committee to research future development. The county has an employee who helps to write grants for communities. The goal is to have a vision and a plan for Nelsonville that is focused on development that benefits business, the community, and family.

Communication methods were discussed: How to conduct community surveys – online form, flyers, Facebook, Website, and more.
