Correspondence – Nelsonville received General Transportation Aids in the amount of \$949.62 in July. The Wisconsin Towns Association has requested municipalities pass a resolution concerning funding for roads.

Wally Leppen gave a report on the Local Roads Improvement Program. Nelsonville received \$11,029.05 for road repairs. He put a daily ad in the Portage County Gazette for two weeks. Nelsonville budgeted \$36,000 for two projects.

CITIZENS CONCERNS: Wally Leppen brought up concerns about the April election results not being posted. Clerk Anderson had posted some results and had assured citizens we would do this in the future as a courtesy. Dave Waller asked about us having an ordinance for not allowing weapons in village hall. There was discussion about drainage on the streets. Also, the next board meeting is on election day so the board meeting date will be August 15th.
