

VILLAGE OF NELSONVILLE  
PARKLAND COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES  
AT THE VILLAGE HALL  
AUGUST 16, 2017 AT 6:00 PM

The meeting was called to order by committee chairperson Dave Mangin.

Present at the meeting were Bobby Bailey, Caitlin Luebke Brillowski and Stacy O'Carroll.

Dave mentioned that he will talk to the neighbors who live close to the SS access point to get their input.

Caitlin presented the Mission Statement for the Park and Recreation Commission.

Bobby made a motion to approve the mission statement as written:

*The Park and Recreation Commission exists to preserve, protect, and maintain safe parkland for recreation, contemplation, and welfare in the Village of Nelsonville. We aim to enrich our community through environmental stewardship, economic stimulation, and education.*

Caitlin seconded the motion.

Dave led a discussion about creating an organizational structure which draws from dreams, goals and objectives; creating a vision for each park, setting goals for each vision and following through with action steps.

It was agreed that all members of the commission would be prepared to share ideas/visions for the park spaces, and that this vision would be developed before calling Tom Dunbar and others for guidance in creating goals and action steps.

The commission members moved out of the Village Hall and took a hike on the Anderson property via the SS access point. Some key talking points brought up during the hike included: A parking lot at the SS access, trail layout and work days, a public interest survey, potential platform for clean water activism, a name for the property, signage in English, Norwegian, and Menominee, and the historic farmstead ruins.

It was agreed the next meeting would take place Wednesday, August 30 at 6:00 PM at the Village Hall.

Caitlin move to adjourn the meeting and Stacy seconded the movement.
